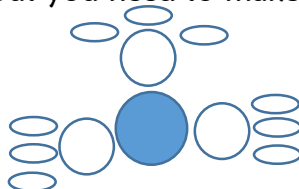

Prewriting

Informative (Informational) Writing

Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Hook☆ Thesis Statement: (tells the reader what will happen in the story, 3 body topics)	
Body: <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Transition Words☆ Topic 1 Introduction Sentence☆ Details about topic 1	
Body: <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Transition Words☆ Topic 2 Introduction Sentence☆ Details about topic 2	
Body: <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Transition Words☆ Topic 3 Introduction Sentence☆ Details about topic 3	
Conclusion: <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Restate (say it again with different words) your thesis☆ Bring it home	
REMINDERS	I will not be used in informational writing.

Opinion Writing

<p>Introduction:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Hook☆ Thesis Statement (shares what you will be writing about)	
<p>Body:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Reason 1☆ Explain☆ Explain☆ Explain	
<p>Body:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Reason 2☆ Explain☆ Explain☆ Explain	
<p>Body:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Reason 3☆ Explain☆ Explain☆ Explain	
<p>Conclusion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">☆ Restate the thesis statement☆ Bring it home and make sure you have shared your opinions!
